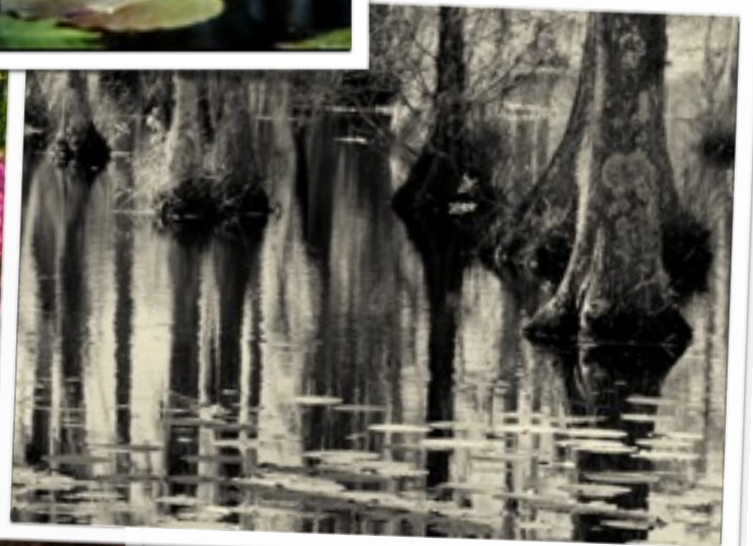


High Dynamic Range
